Activity Procedures:

Before the Hunt

1. Cut out and place the Kilroys around the building. There are 30 on the printable pages but feel free to modify the number so it best fits your population.
2. Send out the slide presentation and arrange with staff when it will be shown. There is a 10 minute video included in the slides. We modified it to better fit our time needs.
3. Modify the worksheet to meet your build needs and expectations.
4. Give each team/ homeroom a worksheet.

During the Hunt

5. Send an email with a reminder of the rules the morning of.
6. Staff introduce Kilroy through slides.
 - a. Slide 1: Ask students, What is a meme? Wait for them to answer
 - b. Slide 2: Read the definition and then ask "What are some memes that are popular now? Wait for a few answers.
 - c. Slide 3: Show them what Kilroy looks like
 - d. Slide 4: Show the video
 - e. Slide 5: Go over the activity
 - f. Slide 6: Go over the rules
7. Students and staff spot the Kilroys throughout the day and report back to their worksheet keeper.
8. Finished worksheets, or ones that have reached the goal, turn their papers into the designated location. We did ours as a raffle instead of making it the first to complete.

After the Hunt

9. Award prizes and spotlight the winning homerooms.

Debrief Questions:

- What is a meme?
- Where did the name Kilroy come from?
- What kind of places did Kilroy make it to during the war? How about here at school?
- Where would you put a Kilroy today?
- In what ways did Kilroy impact soldiers' mental or emotional health?
